

How to BUY it

- You can purchase the pass at the Dohoku Bus company office, Asahikawa Denikidou Bus company office, Asahikawa Tourist Information Center and main Hotels in Asahikawa.
- Purchase is cash only.

What TYPE

- There are 2 kinds of passes :the 1-Day Pass, and the 2-Day Pass. These are valid only on consecutive days.
- The adult fare applies to passengers 12 years old and older.
- The child fare applies to children 1 to 11 years old. (However, 1 child of 1 to 5 years old is free for an accompanying adult pass holder) infants (less than 1 year old)
- A child pass is not sold by itself. It can only be bought in combination with an adult pass. When purchasing a child's pass, you need to show the child's proof of age, such as a passport.

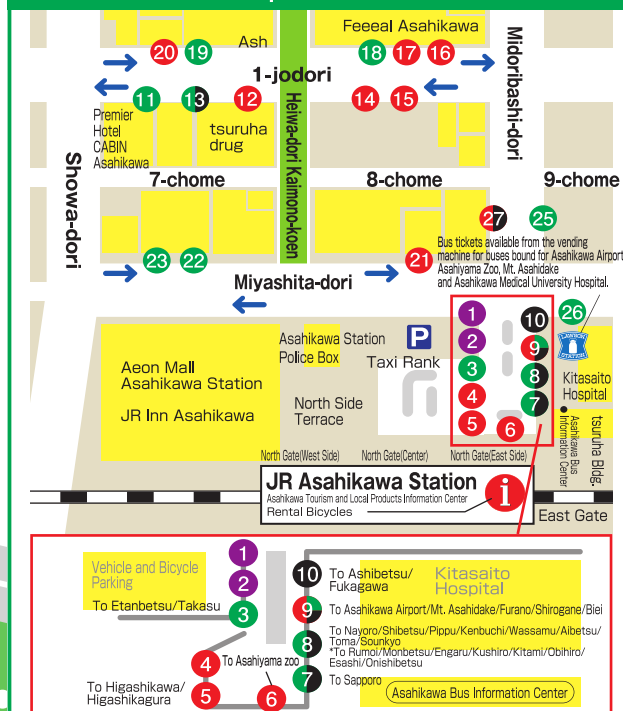
Where to USE

- The Asakuru Pass is valid only for designated service.
- The Pass is invalid for airport busses, Asahidake Line, Sounkyo Line and InterCity busses.

Terms & Conditions

- Asakuru Pass is valid only for the purchaser (the name written on the pass). Giving or selling passes to others is prohibited.
- The pass is valid for the 1 or 2 consecutive days from the day of purchase, depending on the pass. The expiration date is indicated on the pass.
- Delays may be caused by adverse weather and road conditions. If you will be transferring to another form of transportation, we recommend that you leave plenty of time. (We're not responsible for missed connections resulting from delays.)
- All passes are strictly non-refundable and non-reissuable for any reason, even loss or theft. We take no responsibility.
- Other matters not listed in the Terms and Conditions are subject to the transportation contract of each bus operator and the relevant Japanese regulations.

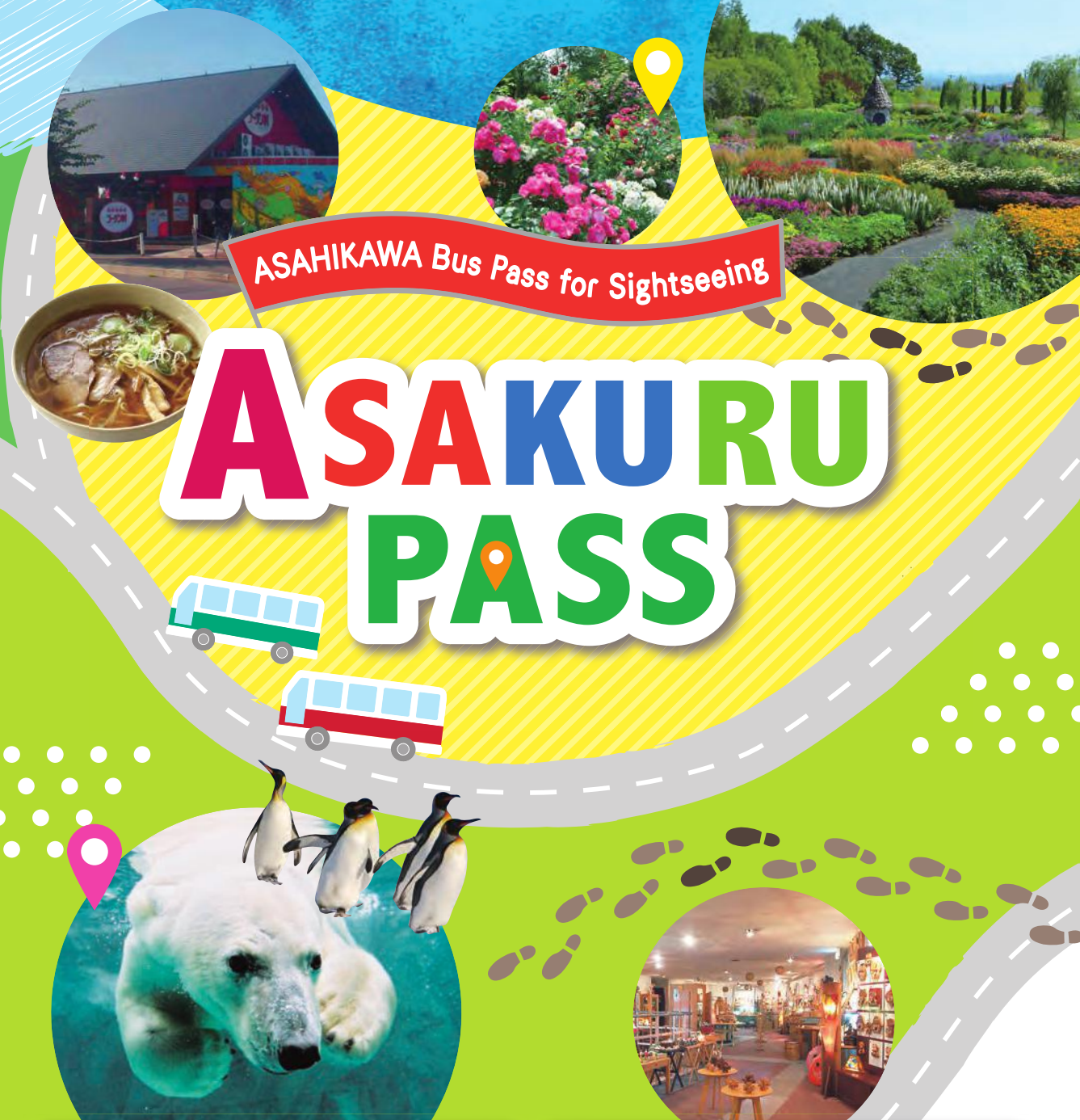

Asahikawa is the birthplace of the iconic Japanese writer, Yasushi Inoue. This exhibition encompasses his 83 years of life, comprising a collection of precious documents, Inoue's original study and drawing room (relocated to Asahikawa from his home in Tokyo), and his hand-written notebooks where he poured out his feelings for his birthplace.

The beautiful Hidaka blue stone Testuro Nishikawa and Seichi Morimura (Seishun no Ryokudo) Monument stands on Nanajo Ryokudo in front of the museum.
